PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Family Advocacy Program

The Family Advocacy Program (FAP) is committed to strong Army Families and the prevention and treatment of Family violence. Its coordinated efforts are designed to promote healthy Family life and to prevent and intervene in cases of Family distress.

Mobilization and Deployment

Deployment is never easy and it often takes a toll on both the Soldier and the Family. The Mobilization and Deployment program provides support services during disaster events and all phases of deployment to eligible family members at, or as near to, their hometown or home installation as possible. Mobilization and Deployment ensures that all Soldiers and civilians returning from deployment or redeployment from other operations are provided support in personal reconstruction, Family reunion and personal readiness.

Financial Readiness & **Army Emergency Relief**

Our Financial Readiness Program offers education, counseling and support services to assist Soldiers and their Families with their financial affairs, including helping them live within their means and invest for the future. Finances are the number one stress in the lives of military Families. The Financial Readiness program offers classes and counseling to resolve problems and relieve this stress. We also offer Army Emergency Relief as reactive assistance when Soldiers and family members require emergency financial assistance.

Exceptional Family Member Program

The Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) is a mandatory enrollment program that works with other military and civilian agencies to provide comprehensive and coordinated community support, housing, education, medical, and personnel services to Families with special needs. Parenting a child with special needs presents unique challenges, and we are here to lend a helping hand.

Relocation Readiness

Moving is a fact of Army life. Relocation Readiness has been an integral part of ACS since 1965. This program is designed to assist Soldiers and Families with transfers and relocations throughout the tour cycle. Employment Readiness Program

Spouses face unique employment challenges, including frequent relocations, lack of career opportunities in and around the base, and financial stressors. The Employment Readiness program provides information and referral services in employment, training, transition and volunteer opportunities to give you the competitive edge needed to secure employment.

Army Volunteer Corps

The Army Volunteer Corps works to promote and strengthen volunteerism by uniting community volunteer efforts, supporting professional management, enhancing volunteer career mobility, and establishing partnerships to support personal growth and life-long volunteer commitment. Volunteering is a defining part of the American experience, and the Army relies on the fundamental connection between volunteerism and citizenship.

Army Family Team Building

Army Family Team Building (AFTB), originally designed by spouses for spouses, is a training and readiness program that provides participants with an understanding of Army culture and the skills and resources they need to become self-reliant, self-sufficient members of the military community. There are three levels of training based solely on an individual's experience in the Army.

Army Family Action Plan

The Army Family Action Plan (AFAP) is a grassroots, Army-wide initiative which provides a way for the Soldiers, Family members, retirees and civilian employees to let the Army leadership know what works and what doesn't – and what they think will fix it. Since 1984, AFAP has been the driving force behind hundreds of legislative, regulatory and policy changes and program and service improvements all geared toward improving the quality of Army life.

Soldier and Family Assistance Center

The Soldier & Family Assistance Center (SFAC) provides guidance, assistance, information and referral and linkage to health care, employment and education services, and other support agencies to facilitate the Wounded Soldier's rapid recovery. The SFAC will work with garrison services and programs to provide a seamless transition and prevent unnecessary procedural delays, and promote conditions that facilitate Soldiers' physical, mental and spiritual healing process.

Outreach

Outreach Programs are designed to link a variety of military and civilian support services with Soldiers, Department of the Army Civilians, and family members. The program seeks to recognize, identify and refer community members to appropriate services in addition to sponsor family events and special programs.

Military & Family Life Consultant Program

Military & Family Life Consultants (MFLCs) provide short-term, situational, problem solving counseling services to individuals, couples, families, and groups. Services are confidential and private. No records are kept. However MFLCs are mandated to reporters of child abuse, domestic abuse, and duty to warn situations.

Cruising the Rhein River

Excursion boats offer a unique way to explore the sights; or combine cable car rides with a boat cruise

oat cruises on the Rhein River offer a relaxing way to spend time with family and friends while taking in some of Germany's most picturesque vistas.

Today's excursion boats cruise swiftly from towns such as Rüdesheim and Bingen up the river past the Loreley to St. Goar or even farther while offering passengers descriptions about the many castles and landmarks along the route.

Reasonably priced traditional German culinary fare is also served during the passage. Enjoy a helping of bratwurst and sauerkraut while sampling one of the local wines as the castles and villages glide by the boat's windows to the accompaniment of the ship guide's descriptions.

Tickets for trips on boats range anywhere from € || roundtrip from Rüdesheim to Bacharach or Lorch to € 16 roundtrip from Bingen to St. Goarshausen. Students with a student ID are half price and children age 4 − 13 pay \in 3.

Families might also want to consider combining a short boat cruise with a couple of cable car rides or a hike and a picnic in the vineyards above Rüdesheim and Assmannshausen.

After wandering through the narrow streets of Rüdesheim and visiting the town's medieval torture museum, hop on the Seilbahn (cable car) for a ride over the vineyards up to the Niederwalddenkmal - a

huge statue of Germania built in the late 19th century to commemorate the reestablishment of the German Empire.From the monument, one can hike back down to Rüdesheim or continue on to a hunting lodge and the top of another cable car which will transport hikers down to the town of Assmannshausen.

A falconry at the top of the mountain also offers families a unique view of birds of prey while visiting the Niederwalddenkmal.

Visitors have several options when purchasing their tickets for the cable car in Rüdesheim. Single and round-trip tickets, Kombi Karten (for single rides on both cable cars) or a Ring Ticket (good for the two cable cars and a boat ride back from Assmannshausen to Rüdesheim) are also available. Tickets range from € 4.50 (€ 2 for children) for a one-way ticket up the mountain to \in 10 (€ 5 for children) for the Ring Ticket.

The Rüdesheim cable car operates from 9:30 a.m. to

5 p.m. weekdays and 9:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Visit www. seilbahn-ruedesheim.de for more information about the cable car.

Several boat cruise companies offer excursion boat rides up the Rhein River. Visit www. bingen-ruedesheimer.de or www.vikingcruises.com for departure times and other special offers.

The Köln-Düsseldorfer excursion boat company is another option for planning longer or themed excursion boat rides between the cities on the Rhein River. Visit www. k-d.com for information about special trips and tours.

Or consider stopping by the Rhein Main Area USOs to find out about their upcoming Rhein River cruises.

ore than 20 original buildings and houses from the middle of the Neckar region and the Swabian Highlands (Schwäbische Alb) frame the museum village in Beuren.

The visitor gets the chance to experience the true to the original view of a Swabian village during the 1700s that relates the stories of people who lived and worked there.

The Freilichtmuseum (open-air museum) in Beuren offers fascinating events for adults and children starting by the end of March until the beginning of October. Everybody is invited to participate in various activities from playing with chickens, rabbits, sheep or goats to baking bread at the museum's authentic baking house. The oven is heated with wood and the visitor is able to produce everything from cakes, pastry, Brötchen (rolls) to Hefezopf (a type of sweet bread with raisins).

Besides farmhouses, stables and barns, the visitor also gets an impression of workshops from craftsmen's families, a weaving mill, a carpenter's workshop and the original village town hall.

A must see is the old "Aunt Helene Store" where you can buy all kinds of old-style goodies – the candy is still stored in big old candy jars. For the complete event program, tours (also in English), directions and prizes, visit www.freilichtmuseum-beuren.de or call civ. 07025-911-9033.

While in Beuren, make sure to include the "Panorama Therme" in your program. Mineral water flows into the three interior and four exterior pools of the Therme.
